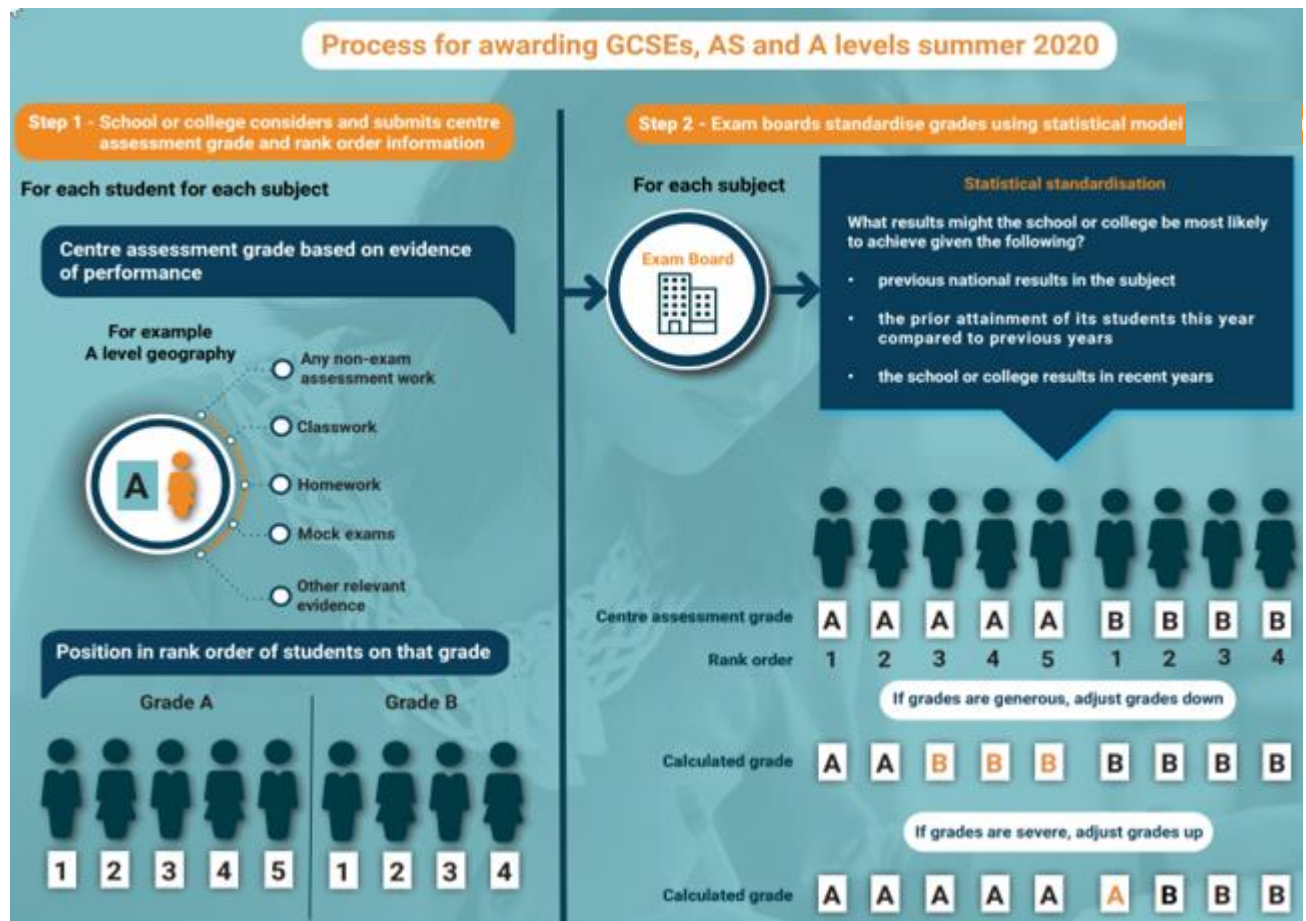


GCE/GCSE EXAMINATION RESULTS SUMMER 2020



This infographic should explain to you the process by which you will have been awarded grades this summer:



- The grades we submitted to the exam boards were agreed following a complex internal quality assurance process and are not the sole responsibility of any individual teacher. Your subject teacher, the Head of Faculty and the Senior Leadership Team have discussed and agreed your grades.
- This was the fairest possible approach available under extreme circumstances. It is a rigorous process which means that grades awarded this year are as valid as in any other year. This will allow pupils to progress to the next stage of their lives in the normal way
- There is certain to be some mismatch between centre-assessed grades and the final grades awarded by exam boards to ensure consistency in grade distribution between years, and this was recognised in the process that was used.
