## Your Governing Body

The Governing Body represents the local community in the running of the school. It is made up of parents, staff, people appointed by the local authority and people who are co-opted by the Governors themselves. Governors are mainly concerned with policy and strategy and the Headteacher and staff are accountable to the Governing Body. ### **The provision made for learners to participate in sport at the school including the provision for the extracurricular sports activities during the period since the last report:**

The Department take great pride in providing as many opportunities for learners to become fit and healthy through participating in sporting activities. There has been a lack of sporting fixtures over the last year due to Covid restrictions and adherence to Welsh Government restrictions and guidance.
